- Pacing while praying is permissible, running is not
- Please do not travail or rest in the Spirit near the entrance of the prayer room or in the hallways

Belongings

- Feel free to bring beverages or snacks into the prayer room, but please clean any up spills
- Belongings should not be left for more than 20 minutes
